Delegations will find attached information a table concerning the implementation of Council Framework Decision 2006/783/JHA of 6 October 2006 on the application of the principle of mutual recognition to confiscation orders (OJ L 328, 24.11.2006, p. 59). In accordance with Article 22, the Framework Decision should have been implemented by 24 November 2008.
