Pursuant to Article 16 of the Framework Decision 2009/948/JHA of 30 November 2009 on prevention and settlement of conflicts of exercise of jurisdiction in criminal proceedings, and Article 27 of the Framework Decision 2009/829/JHA of 23 October 2009 on the application, between Member States of the European Union, of the principle of mutual recognition to decisions on supervision measures as an alternative to provisional detention, please be kindly informed, that the aforementioned Framework Decisions were implemented into the Polish law by the act of 31 August 2012 amending the Code of Penal Procedure.

Part of the new provisions (implementing the FD 2009/948/JHA) entered into force on 17 October, the other part (implementing FD 2009/829/JHA) will enter into force on 1 December 2012. You will find the text of relevant provisions attached.

The Polish authorities inform the Member States that according to Article 14 of the FD 2009/948/JHA Polish authorities will accept Polish as the language in the procedure of taking contact.
