Subject :	<b>Council Framework Decision 2009/829/JHA</b> on the application, between Member States of the European Union, of the principle of mutual recognition to decisions on supervision measures as an alternative to provisional detention - Notification of the implementation of Framework Decision 2009/829/JHA of the Council of the European Union of 23 October 2009 (OJ L 294)

Pursuant to Article 27(2) of Council Framework Decision 2009/829/JHA of 23 October 2009 on the application, between Member States of the European Union, of the principle of mutual recognition to decisions on supervision measures as an alternative to provisional detention (OJ L 294), the Netherlands Government hereby notifies you that the Framework Decision has been fully implemented by the Law of 5 June 2013 implementing Framework Decision 2009/829/JHA of the Council of the European Union of 23 October 2009 on the application, between Member States of the European Union, of the principle of mutual recognition to decisions on supervision measures as an alternative to provisional detention (OJ L 294). The law was published in No 250 of the Bulletin of Acts and Decrees and will enter into force on 1 November 2013.

A copy of the law and an explanatory note, including a correlation table, are enclosed. The decree implementing the law (together with an explanation) and the decree governing the entry into force are also enclosed.

By virtue of these arrangements, the Netherlands government considers that Framework Decision 2009/829/JHA has been fully implemented.
