I have the honour to notify the General Secretariat of the Council of the European Union on the implementation by Romania of the **Framework Decision no. 2005/214/JHA of the Council of 24th of February 2005** on the application of the principle of mutual recognition to financial penalties, published in the Official Journal of the European Union no. L 76 of 22nd of March 2005.

Having in view that by Law no. 300 from 15 November 2013 for the amendment and supplemental of the Law no. 302/2004 on the international judicial cooperation in criminal matters, published in the Official Gazette of Romania on 11 December 2013 there have been certain amendments to the provisions concerning the transposition of the Framework Decision no. 2005/214/JHA of the Council of 24th of February 2005 on the application of the principle of mutual recognition to financial penalties, Romania *hereby supplements* its notification as it follows:
