**Withdrawal of a declaration and submission of information relating to the competent authority under Council Framework Decision 2006/783/JHA**

Sweden hereby withdraws the declaration previously submitted in accordance with Article 7(5) of Council Framework Decision 2006/783/JHA on the application of the principle of mutual recognition to confiscation orders. From 1 July 2014 Sweden will therefore be able to recognise and execute orders including those issued under the extended powers of confiscation referred to Article 2(d)(iv) of the Framework Decision.

We also submit the following additional information in accordance with Article 3 of the Framework Decision. From 1 July 2014, where Sweden is the executing State, its courts are also competent authorities in accordance with the Framework Decision. All orders and accompanying certificates should however continue to be sent to the Swedish Enforcement Authority in accordance with the information previously submitted.
