"The experts noted that the time taken for the High Court to deal with Habeas Cases is dependent on many factors. These may include the state of preparedness of both sides for hearing of the case and whether extra information was requested by the Court. There was liberty to apply for a writ of Habeas Corpus at any time prior to the surrender being undertaken."
