**Notification by the Slovak Republic regarding Framework Decision 2008/909/JHA on the application of the principle of mutual recognition to judgments in criminal matters imposing custodial sentences or measures involving deprivation of liberty for the purpose of their enforcement in the European Union**

The Slovak Republic hereby issues the following notification:

**Article 26(4):**

'On 29 October 2012, the Protocol amending the Treaty between the Slovak Republic and the Czech Republic on legal assistance provided by judicial bodies and on the settlement of certain legal relations in civil and criminal matters of 29 October 1992 and the final protocol thereto was signed. The Protocol entered into force on 1 December 2014.'
