Dear Secretary-General,

In relation to Council Framework Decision 2009/948/JHA of 30 November 2009 on prevention and settlement of conflicts of exercise of jurisdiction in criminal proceedings, I am pleased to inform you that under Law 16/2015 of 7 July 2015 governing the status of Spain's national member in Eurojust, conflicts of jurisdiction, international judicial cooperation networks and staff of the Ministry of Justice posted abroad, published in Official State Gazette No 1622 of 8 July 2015, the aforementioned Framework Decision has been fully transposed into our legal system.

The third final provision of the aforementioned law also states that its enacting terms transpose into Spanish law **Council** Decision 2009/426/JHA of 16 December 2008 on the strengthening of Eurojust and amending **Decision 2002/187/JHA setting up Eurojust with a view to reinforcing the fight against serious crime, as well as** Council Decision 2008/976/JHA of 16 December on the European Judicial Network.

A copy of the aforementioned Law 16/2015 of 7 July 2015 is enclosed herewith<sup>1</sup>.
