Notification of a change in national law in respect of the judicial authority

In view of the outcome of European Court of Justice Case C-452/16 PPU, Poltorak, Sweden has amended its national law in respect of the *judicial authority* (Article 6(1) of Council Framework Decision 2002/584/JHA of 13 June 2002 on the European arrest warrant and the surrender procedures between Member States) in cases where Sweden is the issuing State. Pursuant to Article 6(3) of the Framework Decision, the General Secretariat of the Council is hereby notified of the following.

As of 19 December 2016, the Swedish Prosecution Authority is the competent authority within the meaning of Article 6(1) of Council Framework Decision 2002/584/JHA of 13 June 2002 on the European arrest warrant and the surrender procedures between Member States in cases where Sweden is the issuing State.

The amendments were made in a decree which entered into force on 19 December 2016. Pursuant to Article 34(2) of the Framework Decision, Member States must transmit to the Council and to the Commission the text of the provisions. The text of the provisions is being transmitted to the Commission via the MNE implementation database.
