Please find in the Annex notifications by Greece under Council Framework Decision 2009/829/JHA of 23 October 2009 on the application, between Member States of the European Union, of the principle of mutual recognition to decisions on supervision measures as an alternative to provisional detention ('supervision measures').

**Notification under Article 6(1):**

Where Greece is the issuing State, the competent authority is the court or the investigator that issued the decision.

Where Greece is the executing State, the competent authority is the Public Prosecutor of First Instance of the place where the person has the habitual residence.

**Notification under Article 7(3):**

The Ministry of Justice is the central authority.

**Notification under Article 8(2):**

Greece is prepared to monitor the measures referred to under points b) and c) of Article 8(2).

**Notification under Article 9(3):**

The Greek authorities may consent to the forwarding of a decision on supervision measures in cases pursuant to Article 9(2), under the following conditions:

The Public Prosecutor of the court issues the decision of the supervision measures or the investigating authority subject to court may transmit the decision to the Member State where the supervised has habitual residence, if the supervised, informed about these measures, agrees to return to that place.

The said Public Prosecutor may upon request of the supervised person to transmit the decision directly to the competent authority of the other Member State, but not to the Member State of the habitual residence, if this authority agrees.

**Notification under Article 21(3):**

Greece will apply Article 2(1) of FD 2002/584 on the EAW in deciding on the surrender of the person concerned to the issuing State.

**Notification under Article 24:**

Greece accepts certificates in the Greek language.

**Notification under Article 27(2):**

A copy of our implementing legislation, which entered into force on 15 November 2014, is attached.<sup>1</sup>
