Notifications

On 23 December 2003 the Parliament of the Republic of Hungary adopted Law CXXX of 2003, Chapters I and II and Annexes 1 and 2 of which concern cooperation with European Union States in criminal matters, transposing into internal law the Framework Decision on the European arrest warrant and the surrender procedures between Member States (2002/584/JHA). In accordance with Article 34(2) of the Framework Decision, we enclose the text of the relevant Hungarian law which will come into force on 1 May 2004.

On 13 June 2002 the Republic of Hungary sent the following notifications to the Council in accordance with the Framework Decision on the European arrest warrant and the surrender procedures between Member States and Law CXXX of 2003 concerning cooperation with European Union States in criminal matters:

In accordance with Article 6(3) of the Framework Decision

For the purposes of conducting a criminal prosecution, the issuing judicial authority is the court with competence and jurisdiction in the matter. For the purposes of executing a custodial sentence or a detention order, the issuing judicial authority is the criminal court with competence and jurisdiction in the matter.

The executing judicial authority is the Court of Budapest, with exclusive jurisdiction.

In accordance with Article 7(2) of the Framework Decision

The central authority of the Republic of Hungary is the Ministry of Justice which is involved in the administrative transmission and reception of European arrest warrants as well as any other official correspondence relating to them.

In accordance with Article 8(2) of the Framework Decision

The Republic of Hungary accepts the European arrest warrant in Hungarian or a translation of it into Hungarian.

In relation to Member States which do not exclusively accept the European arrest warrant in their own official language or in one of their official languages or accompanied by a translation in one of those languages, the Republic of Hungary accepts the European arrest warrant in English, French and German or accompanied by a translation in one of those languages.

In accordance with Article 25(2) of the Framework Decision

The Ministry of Justice is the central authority of the Republic of Hungary responsible for receiving transit requests and any other official correspondence relating to them.

For the purposes of conducting a criminal prosecution, the issuing judicial authority is the court with competence and jurisdiction in the matter. For the purposes of executing a custodial sentence or a detention order, the judge responsible for penitentiary affairs has the competence and jurisdiction to issue a European arrest warrant.

The executing judicial authority is the Metropolitan Court, with exclusive competence and jurisdiction."
