Article 6(3) of the Framework Decision:

Competent issuing judicial authority:

The examining magistrate is competent for a European arrest warrant for purposes of prosecution and the Chief Public Prosecutor is competent for a European arrest warrant for purposes of enforcement of a sentence or order.

Competent executing judicial authority:

The public prosecutor's office, the examining magistrate and the pre-trial chamber at the relevant district court and, on appeal, the Chief Public Prosecutor and the pre-trial chamber at the High Court in Luxembourg.

Article 8(2) of the Framework Decision:

Luxembourg states that it will accept a European arrest warrant in English.

Article 25(2) of the Framework Decision:

The Chief Public Prosecutor is the authority responsible for receiving transit requests and the necessary documents, as well as any other official correspondence relating to transit requests.
