Article 3	<p>The Belgian authority competent to issue a European protection order is the public prosecutor of the place where the national protection measure has been adopted.</p> <p>The Belgian authority competent to recognise a European protection order is the Public Prosecutor of the place where the protected person resides or stays (or plans to reside or stay).</p>
Article 4	Belgium has not designated a central authority.
Article 17 §3	The certificate should be drawn up in or translated into French, Dutch, German or English.
