On behalf of the German Presidency of the European Union, I have the pleasure to invite you to the **12th National Correspondents Meeting of the European Judicial Network** taking place on:

30 September 2020
in
The Hague, The Netherlands

Taking into account the current situation, the Presidency, the EJM Presidency Board and the EJM Secretariat have concluded that the NCM should be organised as a physical meeting. We have received confirmation from several of you that you will be able to participate in person. Depending on the development in the coming period, we will re-assess if we can go ahead with having the meeting in The Hague or if we would need to organise it as a videoconference.

In any case, in view of the restrictions in the travel, the EJM Secretariat will provide a possibility for participation in the meeting via video link for those that cannot attend in person in The Hague.

Among the discussion points during the meeting will be, *inter alia*, the EJM Work Programme and Budget, the redesign of the EJM website, the EJM Peer Evaluation and updates concerning matters such as EAW and projects related to Digital Criminal Justice and EU Commission platform e-DES.

The meeting venue in The Hague will be confirmed on a later stage. Please note that the accommodation in Crowne Plaza Hotel (The Hague) and travel expenses (up to 350 euro) for 1 participant per Member State will be covered by the EJM budget.
