SUBJECT: Declarations pursuant to Regulation (EU) 2018/1805 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 14 November 2018 on the mutual recognition of freezing orders and confiscation orders

Within the meaning of Articles 4(2), 6(3), 14(2) and 17(3) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1805 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 14 November 2018 on the mutual recognition of freezing orders and confiscation orders, the Republic of Croatia hereby notifies you of the following:

**Declaration in accordance with Article 4(2)**

When a freezing certificate is transmitted to the Republic of Croatia with a view to the recognition and execution of a freezing order, the original freezing order or a certified copy thereof must be transmitted together with the freezing certificate.

**Declaration in accordance with Article 6(3)**

Freezing certificates should be translated into Croatian, but in urgent cases a translation into English will be accepted subject to reciprocity.

**Declaration in accordance with Article 14(2)**

When a confiscation certificate is transmitted to the Republic of Croatia with a view to the recognition and execution of a confiscation order, the original confiscation order or a certified copy thereof must be transmitted together with the confiscation certificate.

**Declaration in accordance with Article 17(3)**

Confiscation certificates should be translated into Croatian, but in urgent cases a translation into English will be accepted subject to reciprocity.
