NOTIFICATIONS REQUIRED UNDER REGULATION (EU) 2018/1805

Competent authorities

Article 24(1)

Article 2(8), point (a)

In Finland **the issuing authority** for a freezing order is the prosecutor or court that issued it.

Article 2(8), point (b)

In Finland **the issuing authority** for a confiscation order is the Legal Register Centre.

Article 2(9)

In Finland **the executing authority** for a freezing order is a prosecutor.

In Finland **the executing authority** for a confiscation order is the Legal Register Centre.

Central authority

Article 24(2)

The central authority for the purposes of Article 24(2) of the Regulation is the Ministry of Justice. The Ministry of Justice is responsible for assisting the competent authorities with communication regarding transmission of freezing orders and confiscation orders.

Languages

Article 6(3)

The freezing certificate referred to in Article 6(1) of the Regulation must be sent to Finland in Finnish, Swedish or English or, failing that, with a translation into one of those languages attached.

Article 17(3)

The confiscation certificate referred to in Article 17(1) of the Regulation must be sent to Finland in Finnish, Swedish or English or, failing that, with a translation into one of those languages attached.
