Adoption of Framework Decision (2008/947/JHA) on the application of the principle of mutual recognition to judgments and probation decisions with a view to the supervision of probation measures and alternative sanctions

Pursuant to Article 23(2) of Framework Decision (2008/947/JHA) of 27 November 2008 on the application of the principle of mutual recognition to judgments and probation decisions with a view to the supervision of probation measures and alternative sanctions, Denmark hereby declares that the current Danish legislation on cooperation between the Nordic countries concerning enforcement of sentences etc. will continue to apply in relation to Finland and Sweden, insofar as the provisions of that legislation allow the objectives of the Framework Decision to be extended or enlarged and help to simplify or facilitate further the procedures for the supervision of probation measures and alternative sanctions.

We would point out that the deadline for making declarations under Article 23(4) of the Framework Decision is **6 March 2009**.
