**REGARDING REVISED NOTIFICATION BY THE REPUBLIC OF LITHUANIA
PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 12(6) OF COUNCIL FRAMEWORK DECISION 2006/960/JHA**

Pursuant to Article 12(7) of Council Framework Decision 2006/960/JHA of 18 December 2006 on simplifying the exchange of information and intelligence between law enforcement authorities of the Member States of the European Union (OJ L 386, 29.12.2006, p. 89, corrigendum OJ L 75, 15.3.2007, p. 26), and having regard to Council document 12255/08 *LIMITE CRIMORG 120 ENFOPOL 145 ENFOCUSTOM 83 COMIX 613*, we hereby notify that the Republic of Lithuania wishes to apply the following international agreements:

1. Agreement between the Republic of Lithuania and the Kingdom of Spain on cooperation in detecting, investigating and preventing criminal offences, signed in Madrid on 3 December 2007.
2. Agreement between the Government of the Republic of Lithuania and the Government of the Republic of Latvia on cooperation in combating organised crime and other offences and on joint actions in border regions, signed in Vilnius on 7 June 2006.
3. Agreement between the Government of the Republic of Lithuania and the Government of the Republic of Poland on cooperation in combating organised crime and other offences and on joint actions in border regions, signed in Vilnius on 14 March 2006.
4. Agreement between the Government of the Republic of Lithuania and the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany on cooperation in combating organised crime, terrorism and other major crimes, signed in Vilnius on 23 February 2001.
5. Agreement between the Police Department under the Ministry of the Interior of the Republic of Lithuania and the Police Board of the Republic of Estonia and the Estonian Forensic Science Institute on cooperation in the exchange and comparison of DNA profiles in the DNA register, signed in Tallinn on 17 June 2008.
